**“Who Can Regulate Europe’s  
Financial Markets and Intermediaries?”

(Faculty of Law, University of Leicester)**

The organization of financial markets regulation and supervision is still a highly discussed topic in the European political and economic agenda. The current debate centres on the issue of further harmonization of national rules versus the adoption of a new fully centralized regulation with one or more European independent agencies in charge of establishing common rules and coordinating domestic and sectoral supervisory activities. Relationships with national legislation and political bodies are crucial at the current stage while it is widely spread the thought that any progress made in this field may have relevant impact on the future path of convergence and integration across European member states.
